Bring naturalness to your wrist.
Bracelet with beads and a
pendant.



Used items:

44 001 02	Yarn, 2 mm ø, white	25 cm
12 030 31	Large-hole bead, polished, 10/8 mm, natural	1 piece
22 906 06	Metal bead, 8 mm ø, gold	2 pieces
22 904 16	Metal bead, 6 mm ø, pinkish-gold	2 pieces
14 682 640	Large-hole glass bead, transparent metallic, 9 mm ø, brilliant copper	1 piece
22 382 06	Ring, round, 4.6 mm ø, gold	5 pieces
22 200 06	Jewellery clasp, in full, gold	1 piece
22 691 06	Decorative metallic element, round	1 piece
22 742 508	Mini tassel with eyelet, beige/gold	1 piece
22 773 06	Mini metal pendant Leaf, gold	1 piece

Additionally you need:

89 541 00	Flat round pliers	2 pieces
89 379 00	Pointed-tip paper scissors	1 piece
33 397 00	Glue for jewellery	

Ruler, large pin, tinfoil, wooden skewer



Instruction:

- 1 Cut 25 cm off the yarn and tie two knots in the middle. To facilitate the stringing, put some glue for jewellery at the end of the yarn by means of the wooden skewer and shape it into a tip with your fingers.
- 2 String the beads on the right and on the left side of the knot (see illustration). Fix the beads externally with the small ring by crimping it with the flat round pliers.
- 3 Check the length of the bracelet by putting it around your wrist. Take the clasp into account and cut off the yarn evenly. Put some glue for jewellery onto the ends, insert them into the jewellery clasp and squeeze them together with the flat round pliers.
- 4 Mount the decorative metallic element together with the ring between the two knots by means of two flat round nose pliers. Attach the mini tassel and the mini leaf-shaped pendant to the lower eyelet of the decorative element.
