Additionally you need:
$\mathbf{8 9 3 7 8 0 0}$ Craft scissors, 17 cm
1 piece

## Instructions:

1 For the bracelet, you need 50 cm of the waxed cotton cord. First thread 1 metallic bead - gold, 10 Indian beads - black, 1 metallic bead - gold, then the letters "SOPHIA", 1 metallic bead - gold, 10 Indian beads - black, finally 1 metal bead - gold and align all beads centrally.

2 Tie an overhand knot (picture 1) on both sides to keep the beads in place.

3 Now bind the cotton cord ends with a sliding knot (picture 2) and make sure that you can put your hand through the bracelet.

4 Thread 2 metallic beads on each end of the cord and tie them with an overhand knot (picture 1). Cut off the excess length.


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
