



HANDICRAFT TIP

Naturally glowing.
Plain twig pieces turn into a bright candle decoration.

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Used items:

Wreath

65 394 505 Twig pieces, natural, 0.2 - 1.2 cm ø, 7.5 cm, bundle approx. 200 g **30 159 000** Styrofoam flat rings, 20 cm ø

35 014 616 Extreme Sheen, metallic, bottle 59 ml
33 086 00 Quickie glue

39 420 620 Glitter – extra fine, PET, vial of 20 ml

approx. 1.5 bundle 1 piece 1/50 bottle small amount approx. 2 ml

Additionally you need:

Hot melt glue gun (e.g. item no. 33 363 00), Paintbrush (e.g. item no. 37 053 000 - set of brushes Hobby Kreativ, FSC 100%)

Instructions:

- 1 Use the styrofoam flat ring as a shaping tool. Start with the shaping of the loose twig pile and glue the twigs slightly criss-cross around the entire wreath to your liking, while creating a rough wreath shape. Pay attention that no glue drops leak on the styrofoam base, otherwise you will not be able to remove the finished wreath from the base.
- 2 Now glue as many twig pieces criss-cross on top of one another until the wreath satisfies your expectations and the twigs have become evenly distributed. Finally, take off the styrofoam flat ring.

TIP: Colour a few twig ends with paint (e.g. Extreme Sheen paint) and let them dry out. To further enhance the wreath, create a narrow border around the painted edge by means of the Quickie glue and sprinkle some glitter on top, allow to dry and then remove excess glitter by gentle tapping.

Decorate the wreath made by you with e.g. a candle inside a pretty bowl or use it as a door, wall hanging or room decorative wreath.









Used items:

Star

33 086 00

65 394 505 Twig pieces, natural, 0.2 - 1.2 cm ø,

7.5 cm, bundle approx. 200 g

35 014 616 Extreme Sheen, metallic, bottle 59 ml 39 420 620 Glitter - extra fine, PET, vial of 20 ml

Quickie glue

approx. 1 bundle 1/80 bottle small amount

approx. 2 ml

Additionally you need:

Hot melt glue gun (e.g. item no. 33 363 00)

Paintbrush (e.g. item no. 37 053 000 - set of brushes Hobby Kreativ, FSC 100%)

Instructions:

- 1 Start with the outer, shaped twigs and glue them together to form a star.
- 2 Then, starting from the twig ends, glue the twigs criss-cross towards the middle part of the wreath until the star shape satisfies your expectations.

TIP: Colour a few twig ends with paint (e.g. Extreme Sheen paint) and let them dry out. To further enhance the wreath, create a narrow border around the painted edge by means of the Quickie glue and sprinkle some glitter on top, allow to dry and then remove excess glitter by gentle tapping.

Display your self-made star to its best advantage as e.g. a door wreath, wall hanging wreath or as a table decoration.













TIP: If you use the plastic half-ball as a spacer instead of the styrofoam flat ring and lay the twig pieces on it, you can make a decorative bowl out of twig pieces.
