Bath balls in the jar

Used items:

34 224 000	Foamy bath balls	1 pack
34 240 000	Blossom – lavender	1 package
46 049 000	Glass vessel with glass lid, 8cm ø	1 piece
29 055 000	Stamp "Keep calm and have a bubble..."	1 piece
28 390 576	Ink-pad "Memento", black	1 piece
73 113 521	Card A4, plain, FSC Recycled Credit, craft	3 cm × 7cm
80 505 102	Letterhead A4, parchment, FSC Mix Credit, white	3.5 × 7cm
42 000 504	Jute cord on wooden card, 1,5 mm ø sand	
55 352 408	Paper cord, 1,2 mm ø, mint-green	1 m

Additionally you need:

89 378 00 Craft scissors
Stove, basin for water-bath, pot, wooden stick, scissors



Instructions:

- 1 Melt the component A in a heat-resistant basin put in a water-bath on the stove (max. 60°C- do not boil).
- 2 Mix the component B with a component A by constant stirring.
- 3 Finally, stir the component C in.
- 4 Now you can shape the still warm compound into a ball by hand and work in thereby the lavender.
- 5 For best results, put a few lavender flowers on the palm of your hand and roll the ball over them. That way, the lavender adheres well on it.
- 6 Put your ball aside and shape it after a few minutes once more.
- 7 In a meantime, you can finish your paper tag.
- 8 Once your balls have become firm, you can put them into the glass jar and decorate it with ribbons and stamped tag.
