## Used items:


<b>53 354 25</b>	Textile felt, gray	1/2 piece
<b>69 137 000</b>	Micro LED-garland of lights with wire	1 piece
<b>62 499 00</b>	Raw wood balls FSC100% half-drilled, 18 mm ø	1 piece
<b>55 800 102</b>	Long-haired plush, white	7 cm
<b>46 049 000</b>	Glass container with lid	1 piece
<b>30 071 000</b>	Double-sided adhesive tape, extra strong	11 cm

## Additionally you need:

Scissors, glue for the nose, 2x CR2032 batteries

## Instruction:

- 1 Cut the hat from the grey felt by means of the cutting pattern. Tape the felt together with the double-sided tape to form a pointed tip hat that fits on the glass jar.
- 2 Then use again the double-sided adhesive tape to stick the long hair plush to the top edge of the glass jar. Afterwards, glue the raw wood ball in the middle of the top edge of the long hair plush as a nose.
- 3 Put the micro LED garland of lights inside the glass jar to illuminate it.
- 4 Finally, put the lid and the hat on the glass jar – your X-mas gnome is ready!
