Bunny out of concrete

## **Used items:**

 36 089 000
 Casting mould: bunny
 1 piece

 34 152 000
 Creative-cement
 600 g

 38 867 102
 Chalky Finish, white
 1/30 bottle

 33 384 00
 Glue for foil
 5 g

 81 28 3 06
 Mirror foil, gold
 2 × 3 cm

## Additionally you need:

61 217 31 Craft sticks
89 530 00 Sandpaper
37 075 000 Set of brushes
Cooking oil
Plastic container
Kitchen roll
Scales



## Instructions:

1 Grease the mould.

Fill the plastic container with about 60 g of water and then gradually add 600 g of the creative-cement. Stir the mixture until an uniform and castable compound is obtained.

2 Pour the mixture slowly into the prepared mould. Make sure you don't pour up to the top of the mould!

Tap slightly against the mould several times with your fingers, so that potential air bubbles can escape upwards.

Let it dry out overnight.

The next day, you can remove the bunny from the mould by turning the casting mould over and by pressing slightly several times with the palm of your hand against the casting mould until the bunny becomes entirely detached from the mould. If necessary, tap slightly the casting mould onto a soft surface.

3 Allow the demoulded bunny to harden well. At best for several days. For the designing, take some white Chalky Finish paint and paint the upper part of the ears. Let it dry well out.

Afterwards, design the bunny with the glue for foil and the mirror foil according to the package instructions.
