# Cement-tray with glass vessel



## Used items:

<b>34 153 000</b>	Creative-cement	about 2000 g
<b>36 035 000</b>	Casting mould: big square	1 piece
<b>36 036 000</b>	Casting mould: medium square	1 piece
<b>88 431 00</b>	Glass vessel, round, 7,5 cm ø	1 piece
<b>88 434 00</b>	Glass vessel, round, 6,5 cm ø	2 pieces
<b>39 342 508</b>	Granulate beige	1/6 pack
<b>55 748 000</b>	Succulents "Sedum"	1 piece
<b>55 753 000</b>	Mini succulents "Echeveria"	1 piece
<b>55 751 000</b>	Mini succulents "Haworthia"	1 piece
<b>88 081 04</b>	River pebble m.brown	150 g
<b>85 004 11</b>	Iceland moss l.green	1/10 bag
<b>56 661 000</b>	Bark pieces	1 piece



## Instructions:

**1** Coat the big square-shaped casting mould with cooking oil from inside and put it on a stable surface. Then, prepare about 2000g of creative-cement according to package instructions and pour it into the big square-shaped casting mould.

**2** Coat the outer sides of the small square-shaped casting mould with cooking oil and place it centrally into the filled big square-shaped casting mould. Subsequently, the small square-shaped casting mould is going to be weighed down with pebbles in order to reach the desired depth. Let it dry overnight, thereupon you can release the moulds and leave the cement to dry out (one to several days).

**3** Fill the two small glass vessels with some beige granulate and insert respectively one mini succulent "Echeveria" and mini succulent "Haworthia" in the center. Decorate the big glass vessel with iceland moss, river pebble and succulent "Sedum".

**4** Space the finished vessels around the tray and embellish it with branches of your choice.
