# Cement-tray with plastic ball



## Used items:

<b>34 153 000</b>	Creative-cement	about 2500 g
<b>36 035 000</b>	Casting mould: big square	1 piece
<b>36 034 000</b>	Casting mould: circle, 18,5 cm ø	1 piece
<b>55 749 000</b>	Succulent "Echeveria" light green	1 piece
<b>55 753 000</b>	Mini-succulent "Echeveria"	1 piece
<b>39 342 576</b>	Granulate, black	1/2 pack
<b>39 342 508</b>	Granulate, beige	1/4 pack
<b>39 476 800</b>	Plastic-ball, 2-part, 10 cm ø crystal	1 piece
<b>56 661 000</b>	Bark pieces	2 pieces
<b>24 260 22</b>	Elastic wire, 0.25 mm ø silver	2 m



## Instructions:

**1** Coat the square-shaped casting mould with cooking oil from inside and put it on a stable surface. Then, prepare about 2500g of creative-cement according to package instructions and pour it into the big square-shaped casting mould.

**2** Coat the outer sides of the circle-shaped casting mould with cooking oil and place it centrally into the filled square-shaped casting mould. Subsequently, the circle-shaped casting mould is going to be weighed down with pebbles in order to reach the desired depth.

**3** Let it dry overnight, thereupon you can release the moulds and leave the cement to dry out (one to several days).

**4** Then you can fill the cement-tray with black granulate.

**5** Put the plastic ball together, fill it with beige granulate and insert the light green succulent "Echeveria" in the center, then wrap it with some elastic wire.

**6** Wrap the two bark pieces respectively with the elastic wire and lay them on the black granulate in front of the ball.

**7** At the end, fasten the mini succulent "Echeveria" at one corner of the cement-tray.
