Flip-top bottle
with a wire flamingo



Used items:

56 717 000	Glass bottle with handle, height: 27 cm	1 piece
38 866 102	Chalky Finish for glass, white	1/20 can
38 866 266	Chalky Finish for glass, salmon-pink	1/10 can
38 866 264	Chalky Finish for glass, pink	1/50 can
55 396 404	Cord, 2 mm ø, turquoise	55 cm
24 255 000	Floral wire, annealed wooden spool	50 cm
89 259 000	Turntable, 28 cm ø	1 piece
37 103 000	Flat brush, synthetic	1 piece
89 543 000	Wire cutter for jewellery	1 piece



Instructions:

- 1 Clean the bottle before painting with detergent and water.
- 2 Mask the lower range for about 2.5 cm with masking tape. Preferably, remove the flip-top cap.
- 3 To achieve a nice colour gradient of Chalky paint for glass a turntable would be helpful. Thereby, put the bottle as closely as possible to the center and hold the brush soaked with paint onto bottle and rotate evenly the disc.
- 4 The colour gradient in the central area is gonna be achieved with the salmon pink and white paints, leaving the two colours to merge into one another.
- 5 Turn the flamingo hands-free according to the template.
- 6 Hang the flamingo on a turquoise cord by using a self-bent ring.
- 7 After four days drying time, the colour is so hardened that you can fix it in the oven according to the instructions of the label.
- 8 The bottle is afterwards dishwasher safe.
