

## **Used items:**

38 843 102 Cotton bag, unprinted, white

29 186 000 Basic wooden stamp set, 2.2 - 3.7 cm ø

38 500 384 Fabric dve. ultra-blue 38 500 218 Fabric dye, dark orange

**38 952 00** Painting sponge, 50 × 20 × 20 mm

38 024 000 Stencil & brush cleaner

## Additionally you need:

Masking tape Cardboard or thick paper Water for washing out Household sponge



- 1 Pre-wash the cotton bag without fabric softener and flatten it by ironing before you start stenciling. Put a cardboard or a thick paper into the already prepared bag and you can get started.
- 2 Now stick the masking tape at about 6 cm from the bottom to a line one centimetre wide. Grab some orange fabric dye with the painting sponge and spread it onto the blank stripes of the fabric. Then remove the masking tape.
- 3 To spread the fabric dye onto the wooden stamp also use the painting sponge. To do this, put some paint on a pad and dip the painting sponge into the paint. Soak the sponge with paint by gently dabbing before applying it onto the motif of the wooden stamp. Then stamp all motifs of the wood stamp set as a border above the orange line in the ultra-blue and orange fabric dye colours. Repeat the colour application after each stamping.
- 4 Clean the wooden stamps with the cleaner (38 024 000) and some water using a household sponge.
