CANVAS - cotton bag leaves



Used items:

- 38 225 562** Cotton bag, unprinted, slate grey
- 45 099 000** Stencil Leaves A4
- 38 509 620** Metallic fabric dye, brill.gold
- 38 509 606** Metallic fabric dye, silver
- 38 024 000** Stencil & brush cleaner

Additionally you need:

- Cardboard or thick paper
- Water for washing out
- Household sponge

Instructions:

- 1** Pre-wash the cotton bag without fabric softener and flatten it by ironing before you start stenciling. Put a cardboard or a thick paper into the already prepared bag and you can get started.
- 2** Remove the stencil from the carrier sheet and place it on the bag and press it slightly on. Now turn the bag with the handles 90° to the left side.
- 3** Apply the first shaken out metallic fabric dye (brill.gold) onto the right half of the stencil above the leaf motif. On the left half, proceed in the same way with the silver metallic fabric dye. Hold the stencil upwards with one hand. Drag the paints separately by means of the squeegee at a 45°-angle with slight downward pressure. In the middle, while dragging the paint with squeegee, a nice colour gradient is created by mixing the both colours together. Repeat the colour application until the motif is completely stencilled.
- 4** After stenciling, remove the stencil carefully and laterally flat, and clean it immediately with the cleaner (38 024 000) and water using a household sponge.
