CRAFTING IDEA

Lemon-shaped soap

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Used items:

34 235 000	Soap casting mould: oval motif	1 piece
34 228 000	Creative-soap, opaque	about 20 g
34 226 000	Creative-soap, transparent	about 50 g
34 246 160	Soap colour, lemon	about 4 drops
34 254 000	Soap fragrance oil, lime	about 2 drops

Additionally you need

Stove, melt, melting pot, scale, small plastic container, stirring sticks or teaspoon, tablespoon



Instructions:

- 1 Melt about 50g of the transparent creative-soap in a water-bath on the stove (max. 60° do not boil).
- 2 After a complete melting, stir 4 drops of the soap colour lemon and 2 drops of the fragrance oil lime into the liquid soap. Therefore, use a plastic container, a wooden spatula or a teaspoon.
- 3 Now cast the soap in the casting mould and let the soap cool down somehow until a sort of curd forms on the surface.
- Melt about 20g of the opaque soap and pour it over the barely dried soap on which after about 10 minutes a sort of curd has been formed on a surface.

- 5 Let the soap dry well out (at least 2-3 hours, ideally one day). Demould the soap by a slight pressure.
- Tip Let the finished soap dry at best for 2-3 weeks; the longer it ripens, the firmer becomes.
- 6 Depending on the temperature and airiness, the soap can perspire. We therefore recommend to wrap the soap after its demoulding in a transparent foil for flowers (cellophane).
- 7 Clean the soap casting mould and the pots with hot water.
