Lemon-shaped soap

Used items:

| $\mathbf{3 4 2 3 5 0 0 0}$ | Soap casting mould: oval motif | 1 piece |
| :--- | :--- | ---: |
| $\mathbf{3 4 2 2 8 0 0 0}$ | Creative-soap, opaque | about 20 g |
| $\mathbf{3 4 2 2 6 0 0 0}$ | Creative-soap, transparent | about 50 g |
| $\mathbf{3 4 2 4 6 1 6 0}$ | Soap colour, lemon | about 4 drops |
| $\mathbf{3 4 2 5 4 0 0 0}$ | Soap fragrance oil, lime | about 2 drops |

Additionally you need:

Stove, melt, melting pot, scale, small plastic container, stirring sticks or teaspoon, tablespoon


5 Let the soap dry well out (at least 2-3 hours, ideally one day). Demould the soap by a slight pressure.

Tip Let the finished soap dry at best for $2-3$ weeks; the longer it ripens, the firmer becomes.

6 Depending on the temperature and airiness, the soap can perspire. We therefore recommend to wrap the soap after its demoulding in a transparent foil for flowers (cellophane).

7 Clean the soap casting mould and the pots with hot water.
