Dot Painting Stone

Used items:

36 107 000	Silicone casting mould Stone	1 piece
36 990 00	Casting powder "Raysin" 200	approx. 180 g
35 014 616	Extreme Sheen, gold	approx. 1/40 bottle
38 000 576	All Purpose paint, black	approx. 1/50 bottle
38 000 100	All Purpose paint, snow-white	approx. 1/50 bottle
35 014 606	Extreme Sheen, silver	approx. 1/40 bottle
38 876 000	Chalky Finish Clear varnish, soft-touch	approx. 1/50 can

Additionally you need:

35 033 000	Dot Painting metallic stylus	1 piece
37 080 000	Paintbrush set Hobby Kreativ	1 set
89 530 00	Sandpaper set, 40 + 60-grit	1 piece
61 216 31	Craft wooden stick	1 piece
Scales, mixing	geup	





Instructions:

- 1 Mix 180 g of Raysin 200 according to instructions, mix it evenly and pour out the round stone in a casting mould. After about 1 hour, you can turn the mould upside down and remove the stone from the casting mould (demould). Allow the stone to dry thoroughly out for several days.
- 2 Smooth the resulting stone edges with sandpaper.
- 3 Undercoat the stone with the black All Purpose paint.
- 4 Draw small dots with the silver Extreme Sheen paint on a circular area with a diameter of about 1 cm by means of the Dot Painting metallic stylus. Work with the next paint around the resulting silver circle. How you form your circles is up to you. The primed areas can remain as they are. Amazing effects are achieved thanks to many dots. You can make the dots round or oval, large and small. Feel free to be creative!
- 5 Leave to dry well out afterwards.

TIP: In order to protect the stone, you can coat it with Chalky Finish Soft Touch Clear varnish.
