# Wire tree



## Used items:

<b>24 089 000</b>	Wire tree	1 piece
<b>34 504 000</b>	Textile strengthener	1/50 bottle
<b>42 009 576</b>	Braided Recycling yarn, braided, 2 mm	4.20 m

## Additionally you need:

<b>89 537 00</b>	Fabric shears, 21 cm
<b>37 047 000</b>	Brush set Kindergarten+school, FSC 100%
	Crayon, white
	Aluminium foil
	Cardboard

## Instructions:

- 1 Cut a total of 40 strands (10 cm each) from the Braided Recycling yarn. You will need 20 cm later for the hanger.
- 2 Lay each piece of yarn twofold and thread the ends of the yarn through the resulting loop. Tighten well the resulting knot on the wire tree.
- 3 Attach all 40 strands in this way.
- 4 Put the wire tree on the cardboard with aluminium foil. Make sure that the strands are lying next to each other.
- 5 Then coat the yarns on one side with the textile strengthener. Allow to dry thoroughly out.
- 6 When the wire tree is dry and has solidified, take a round object with a diameter of about 9 cm, e.g. a glass, and trace its contour with the white crayon. Cut it out with the fabric shears.
- 7 To hang it up, thread approx. 20 cm of Braided Recycling yarn through the suspension eyelet.
