



### HANDICRAFT TIP

Who's that sitting there?  
A wooden chick on a wire ring.

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### Used items:



46 833 576	Wire ring to hang, ø 10 cm, black	1 piece
39 587 000	Wooden egg set	1 egg
87 102 685	Confetti, ø 2 cm, pastel	approx. 25 - 30 pieces
85 245 02	Grass fibre, white	a few
55 517 258	Yarn, ø 1 mm, pinkish	1,5 m
85 108 02	Decorative feather	4 small feathers
62 485 00	Wooden ball, ø 10 mm	2 pieces
35 077 576	Allround Paint, acrylic, black	some

### Additionally you need:

35 094 000 Decoupage glue  
Paintbrush, scissors, hot-melt glue, needle, poss. pencil

### Instructions:

1 Using decoupage glue, stick the pink confetti onto the lower-third of the egg, overlapping them slightly.



2 To make the beak, place a pink confetti folded into a triangular shape on top of an orange confetti (medium orange shade) of the same triangular shape, and to make the comb, apply the same layering, but with confetti cut into an oval shape.

3 Use the black acrylic paint to draw eye dots.

**TIP:** Leave unpainted a small bean-shaped spot inside each eye. It makes the eyes look more natural.

Glue the comb- and beak-shaped confetti onto the egg together with the feathers as wings.

4 Use the baker's twine to make the legs. To do this, take two pieces of twine, each about 50 cm long, fold them in half and tie their ends together. One end is securely fixed in place, while at the other end you need to insert a stick, e.g. a pencil, and turn the twine while pulling gently on it until it starts to wind itself up. Then bring the ends together (held under gentle tensile traction) in the middle and twist the twine until a cord is formed.

5 Then slide a wooden ball on the end of each cord using a needle and if necessary, secure them in place with some glue. Glue the legs on the egg.

6 For confetti string, glue 2 confetti on top of each other by spacing them evenly on the baker's twine.

7 Shape a tuft of grass fibre into a nest and attach it to the wire ring using hot-melt glue.

8 Glue the young chicken on the wire ring. As a crowning, attach the confetti string in the middle.



## A colourful world of confetti

Whether it's about Räsyn, styrofoam or wood, the translucent paper confetti can be applied on numerous and various surface by means of the decoupage glue. And a wonderful spring-like colour scheme is obtained by overlapping them. Or you could use the confetti for making little decorative paper flowers. Bright colours are in vogue!



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
