## Used items:

<b>30 009 00</b>	Styrofoam mushroom, 13 cm	1 piece
<b>33 492 000</b>	Styrofoam mushroom, assorted	1 bag
<b>30 234 000</b>	Glitter dust adhesive	2/3 bottle
<b>39 584 374</b>	Viscose flocking powder, azure blue	1/10 box
<b>39 584 410</b>	Viscose flocking powder, sea green	1/4 box
<b>39 584 422</b>	Viscose flocking powder, grass-green	1/2 box
<b>34 371 432</b>	Chalky Finish spray, jade	1/15 box
<b>34 371 807</b>	Chalky Finish spray, light topaz	1/10 box
<b>38 759 000</b>	Putty paste	1/5 box

## Additionally you need:

<b>38 032 00</b>	Metallic spatula with flexible blade tip
	Paintbrush

## Instructions:

If the styrofoam mushrooms have a "pressed down seam", this unevenness can be evened out with a fine sandpaper.

### Very large mushroom and small green mushroom with smoothed stem

- 1 Use the spatula to apply the putty paste to the mushroom stem.
- 2 As soon as the putty paste is dry, you can spray the mushroom stem with the light topaz Chalky Finish spray. Let it dry well out.
- 3 Coat the mushroom cap with the glitter dust adhesive, richly and evenly, by means of the flat paintbrush.
- 4 Sprinkle the grass-green viscose flocking powder, quickly and evenly, onto the still wet adhesive, shake off any excess and leave to dry out.

### Medium-sized green mushroom

- 1 Coat the entire mushroom with the glitter dust adhesive, richly and evenly, by means of the flat paintbrush.
- 2 Sprinkle the grass-green viscose flocking powder, quickly and evenly, onto the still wet adhesive, shake off any excess and leave to dry out.

**TIP:** Use a sheet of paper as a pad, so that you can collect easily the flocking powder or the glitter dust and pour it back into the pot.



### Medium-sized mushroom and small sea green mushroom with smoothed stem

- 1 Use the spatula to apply the putty paste to the mushroom stem.
- 2 As soon as the putty paste is dry, you can spray the mushroom stem with the jade Chalky Finish spray. Let it dry well out.
- 3 Coat the mushroom cap with the glitter dust adhesive, richly and evenly, by means of the flat paintbrush.
- 4 Sprinkle the sea green viscose flocking powder, quickly and evenly, onto the still wet adhesive, shake off any excess and leave to dry out.

### Small azure blue mushroom

- 1 Coat the entire mushroom with the glitter dust adhesive, richly and evenly, by means of the flat paintbrush.
- 2 Sprinkle the azure blue viscose flocking powder, quickly and evenly, onto the still wet adhesive, shake off any excess and leave to dry out.
