# Flocked Styrofoam Elephants



## Used items:

<b>33 441 00</b>	Styrofoam elephant	3 pieces
<b>38 000 358</b>	All Purpose paint, baby-blue	1/10 bottle
<b>39 584 358</b>	Viscose flocking powder, baby-blue	½ box
<b>38 000 560</b>	All Purpose paint, light grey	1/10 bottle
<b>39 584 560</b>	Viscose flocking powder, light grey	½ box
<b>38 000 392</b>	All Purpose paint, ind.turquoise	1/10 bottle
<b>39 584 410</b>	Viscose flocking powder, sea-green	½ box
<b>30 234 000</b>	Glitter dust glue	1/5 bottle

## Additionally you need:

<b>89 476 00</b>	Sandpaper, 800 grit	1/3 sheet
<b>37 080 000</b>	Paintbrush set	
<b>61 098 00</b>	Wooden skewer	1 piece

Copy paper

## Instructions:

- 1 First sand smoothly the pressed seam and possibly the pressed spot of the styrofoam elephant with the fine sandpaper. Put the styrofoam elephant on the wooden skewer.
- 2 Prime the styrofoam elephant with the matching All Purpose paint. Let it dry well out for about 30 minutes.
- 3 Coat richly the entire surface of the styrofoam elephant with the glitter dust glue (approx. 1 mm, so that the adhesive does not drip). Sprinkle immediately the viscose flocking powder onto the still wet glitter dust glue. Let it dry well out, preferably overnight. You can put the skewered elephant in a glass for drying.

**TIP:** Work on a sheet of copy paper, so you can pour the excess flocking powder back into its container.
