A lovely Easter surprise. Bunnies made from chenille wire.

Used items:

68 068 000	Bio paper cup with lid, 300 ml	3 pieces
87 212 685	Pompom chenille wiggling eyes	1 bag
67 270 102	Tissue paper, white	1 ½ sheet
35 077 100	Allround Paint acrylic, snow-white	1/50 bottle
35 077 312	Allround Paint acrylic, lavender	1/50 bottle
35 077 160	Allround Paint acrylic, lemon	1/50 bottle
35 077 502	Allround Paint acrylic, eucalyptus	1/50 bottle
55 965 258	Ribbon + cord set, pinkish	1 piece
55 965 356	Ribbon + cord set, light blue	1 piece
55 965 161	Ribbon + cord set, sunny yellow	1 piece
62 688 000	Wooden tray	1 piece
39 589 267	Bio-Glitter, ultra-fine	approx. 0.5 g

Additionally you need:

Glue, scissors, paintbrush, double-sided adhesive tape, hot-melt glue



Instructions:

1 For the purple paper cup, mix the lavender and snow-white acrylic paints in a mixing ratio of 2:1 to obtain a pastel shade. Using a paintbrush, paint the cup with the resulting paint mixture. Allow to dry well out.

2 Cut the yellow cord into four pieces of 9 cm each. Gather these pieces in the middle and stick them on the cup with a large purple pompom to make a nose with whiskers.

3 Cut out a ½ sheet of tissue paper and fold it inhalf, then insert it into the cup - without going over the edge. Now you can fill your cup with the material of your choice.

Once your paper cup is filled, take the chenille wire and bend it into two bunny ears. Then gather the tissue paper with the ears in the middle and tie it all together with a piece of cord as if it were a sweet. Spread the excess paper around the edge of the cup. 5 Make a small bow with the ribbon and stick it on a rabbit's ear. If desired, glue the wiggling eyes above the pompom (nose). Repeat all these steps with the other two colours (yellow and eucalyptus).

• The final step would be to paint the entire wooden tray with white acrylic paint. Allow to dry well out.

7 Glue the double-sided tape along the top edge of the tray, then peel off the protective foil and sprinkle the sticky side of the tape with glitter. To further enhance your masterpiece, you could scatter the rest of the pompoms over the tray.
