Suspended heart-shaped wire.



## Used items:

<b>24 117 000</b>	Wire heart, ø 25 cm	1 piece
<b>44 003 02</b>	Yarn, ø 3.7 mm, white	4.5 m
<b>85 493 000</b>	Eucalyptus bunch with paper sleeve	1/4 bunch
<b>34 242 000</b>	Blossoms – rosebuds, pink	5 buds
<b>24 261 00</b>	Brass wire, ø 0.3 mm	2 m
<b>55 215 02</b>	Organza ribbon, white	1 m
<b>80 505 102</b>	Note paper A4, parchment, white	
<b>73 234 276</b>	Paperado cardboard DIN A4, fuchsia	
<b>73 234 258</b>	Paperado cardboard DIN A4, pinkish	

## Additionally you need:

- 69 102 000** Motif punch set: Hearts
- 33 487 000** Glue Fix pen
- Hot-melt glue gun, scissors



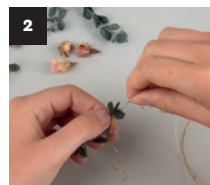
## Instructions:

**1** First cut off 4.5 m of the yarn. Affix one end with a drop of hot-melt glue to the tip of the heart-shaped wire. Now the whole heart needs to be densely covered with yarn. Then stick the end back on firmly.

**2** Take 4 small twigs of eucalyptus. Starting at one end, attach them to the brass wire, spacing them about 8 cm apart. You could ripple the wire slightly between the twigs. Do the same thing on the other end of the wire, but this time with 5 rose buds.

**3** For the suspension hook, cut off 50 cm of the yarn, knot its ends together and attach it to the top centre of the heart. Tie the brass wire with the 1 m organza ribbon in the middle of the top of the heart.

**4** Now punch out various hearts from the different paper sheets. And finally, attach them to the white organza ribbon by means of the Glue Fix pen.
