



CRAFTING IDEA

Dinner is served! Wicker trays and napkin holder.

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Used items:

64 653 505 36 990 00	Wood deco tray set, natural Casting powder "Raysin" 200	1 set 1 bag
36 183 000	Silicone moulds Mini pot set	1 set
65 029 00	Rattan strip 4 mm	as required
35 077 105	Allround Paint acrylic, alabaster white	1/20 bottle
35 077 452	Allround Paint acrylic, avocado	1/20 bottle
35 077 502	Allround Paint acrylic, eucalyptus	1/20 bottle
65 398 505	Rattan wickerwork, natural	1 roll
65 397 505	Viennese wickerwork, natural	1 roll
64 650 505	Wooden blocks + sheets set, natural	1 set

Additionally you need:

30 070 000 Double-sided adhesive tape, extra strong Paintbrush, scissor, hot-melt glue

Instructions:

Trays

- 1 Cast the mini Raysin pots following the instructions as given in the manual and after they have dried, arrange them on the trays.
- 2 Paint each tray with the Allround Paint.
- 3 Then cut pieces of rattan and Viennese wickers tailored to the size of the inner surface of the trays. Once the paint is completely dry, glue the cut pieces to the bottom surface of the trays using the hot-melt glue.
- 4 You could also enhance the inner edges of the trays by gluing pieces of rattan strips to them using the double-sided adhesive tape.

Napkin holder

To make the napkin holder, you'll need two wooden blocks measuring 12×2.5 cm and four wooden blocks measuring 9.5×2.5 cm.

- 1 Glue the two blocks (12 × 2.5 cm) together, joining their narrow edges. As for the front and rear panel, glue a block (9.5 × 2.5 cm) on each side of the narrow edge.
- 2 Then glue the front and rear panel in the middle of the front and back edges of the 12 cm long blocks that you have glued together.
- 3 Prepare two Viennese wicker cuttings, each measuring 9.5 × 5 cm. Then glue them to the front and rear side of the napkin holder.
