„The stars shine above..“  
Wintry wood lantern.

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## Used items:

<b>64 644 505</b>	Wood lantern Basic, natural	1 piece
<b>73 225 562</b>	Paperado card, slate grey	½ sheet
<b>73 225 408</b>	Paperado card, mint green	½ sheet
<b>23 009 000</b>	3D star-effect foil	½ roll
<b>69 137 000</b>	Micro LED string lights with wire	1 piece
<b>23 050 00</b>	Acetate crystal-clear sheet	1 piece

## Additionally you need:

<b>69 153 000</b>	Motif puncher: Star, 7,6 cm ø
<b>89 794 000</b>	Motif puncher: Star, 3,81 cm ø
<b>69 001 000</b>	Hole punch motif Star, 6 mm ø
<b>33 487 000</b>	Glue fix pen
<b>30 071 000</b>	Double-sided adhesive tape extra strong

## Instructions:

- 1 Cut 4 cuttings out of 3D star-effect foil, each measuring 12 × 19 cm.
- 2 Make a cutout measuring 12 × 19 cm from the slate grey card and one of the same size from the mint green card.
- 3 Punch out stars from the previously made cuttings using both star motif punchers.
- 4 Glue each 3D star-effect foil cutting behind each coloured cutout.
- 5 Glue a cutting on each of the 4 wooden sides of the lantern.
- 6 Assemble and glue the lantern by following the instructions.
- 7 To finish, stick the cut-out stars onto each side of the 3D star-effect foil.



**TIP:** If you want to put a string of lights in the lantern, it's best to roll it up on a transparent roll. The best solution for the roll would be an acetate sheet or a clear glass that matches the inner size of the lantern. Wind the string of lights around the roll or glass and place it in the middle of the lantern.

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
