Wooden bead tree inside a metal ring

Used items:

63 505 000	Raw-wood balls collection box	
	Raw-wood balls, 10 mm ø	25 pieces
25 050 01	Coated metal rings, 10 cm ø	1 piece
24 116 505	Paper covered wire, 0.55 mm ø	1 m

Additionally you need:

89 279 00 Side cutter, 15 cm

Instructions:

1 Thread 2 raw-wood balls on 1 m of paper covered wire and push them into the middle.

2 Thread 2 raw-wood balls onto the left wire end and also thread them through with the right wire end. Tighten the paper covered wire firmly.

3 Repeat this step with 2 more raw-wood balls.
Align in such a way that the 6 raw-wood balls are centered on top of each other and form the trunk of the tree. Tighten the paper covered wire firmly.

4 Now thread 2 beads each on the right and left end of the wire, there are then 6 raw-wood beads in a row.

5 Thread 5 raw-wood balls onto the right wire end and bend to the left over the lower row. Thread the left wire end through the 5 raw-wood balls and tighten them firmly.

6 Repeat the same thing by always threading one less raw-wood ball than in the lower row. Until there is only one raw wood ball left, as the tip of the tree.

7 Bend the ends of the paper covered wire upwards and twist them together.

Now you can bend the paper covered wire into a hook, as a hanger and attach it to the metal ring.
