## **Instructions:**

- 1 Spread the Chalky blocker over the inner and outer sides of the wooden tray. Let it dry for 5-7 days.
- 2 Paint the inner and outer sides with the mint Chalky paint. Let it dry well.
- The cork cutting with the help of the sponge for painting and the white Chalky paint will be wiped with a glaze effect.
- 4 Cut out the cork fabric according to the wooden tray bottom. Spread the glue for cork onto the bottom and lay the pre-cut cork fabric sheet on it. Let it dry well.
- 5 Paint carefully afterwards the visible edges with the white Chalky paint.

- 6 Clean the vase before designing by using a detergent.
- 7 Apply generously the white Chalky Finish for glass on the vase by using the sponge for painting.
- Sand afterwards the vase with a sandpaper in order to achieve a Vintage Look.
- After four days, the paint is cured, so that you can fix it in the oven according to the instructions on the label. Then the vase is dishwasher safe.
