



CRAFTING IDEA

Luminous row of houses. Glass candle jar with paper silhouettes.

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Used items:

87 435 102	Paper silhouette Mountain village, white	1 bag
46 757 000	Glass vase, 15 cm ø	1 piece
36 990 00	Casting powder "Raysin" 200, white	300 g
36 125 000	Silicone casting mould Round coaster	1 piece
31 659 000	Candle-shaped mould,cylindric,flat, 7 cm ø	1 piece
31 042 02	Wax pellets, white	300 g
31 005 00	Flat wick for candles with ø of 30 to 60 mm	15 cm
38 100 102	Frost-effect paint, white	1/20 bottle
55 961 000	Ribbon display "Nature X-Mas" (natural cord)	250 cm
46 722 000	Fir cones, mini	26 pieces
69 136 000	Micro LED string lights with wire	1 piece
39 486 000	Glass pebbles transparent	approx. 300 ml

Additionally you need:

30 068 000 Special double-sided adhesive tape

33 487 000 Glue fix pen

38 952 00 Sponge for painting

Wax melting accessories, hot-melt adhesive, 2 button batteries, masking tape

Instructions:

- 1 First, the coaster needs to be cast using the Raysin and the round casting mould.
- 2 Before covering the glass evenly to within 2 cm of its top edge with masking tape, clean it with water and washing-up liquid.
- 3 Take some frost-effect paint with the sponge paint dabber and apply it in small dabs to the free area next to the masking tape. Then remove the masking tape and allow the paint to dry thoroughly.
- 4 Adjust the paper silhouette to the glass and stick it neatly at about 1.5 cm from the bottom by means of the special double-sided adhesive tape.
- 5 Around the empty space between the bottom of the glass and the paper silhouette, wind the natural cord twice and knot it off tightly. Then glue the small fir cones on, as evenly as possible, using hot-melt glue.
- 6 You also need to wind the natural cord twice over the fir cone wreath.

- 7 Then wind the LED string lights between the cones to fix them in place and to light up the wreath in an exceptional way.
- 8 Melt the wax pellets according to the instructions given, pour them in liquid form into the candle mould, cast with the wick inserted, allow to cool down, then demould it.
- 9 Once you've demoulded the coaster and inserted the button batteries, you can decorate the lantern with the candle.

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
