Wintry gnome trio.
Cast in a flash.

Used items:

36 144 000	PET Casting mould Gnome, small	1 piece
36 990 00	Casting powder "Raysin" 200, white	approx. 120 g
34 479 576	Casting powder "Raysin" 250, black	approx. 110 g
34 463 558	Creative-cement 5in1	approx. 150 g
35 077 100	Allround acrylic paint, snow-white	1/100 bottle
33 384 00	Glue for foil	1/50 bottle
81 283 06	Mirror foil, gold	some

Additionally you need:

Water, mixing container, paintbrush, sandpaper if needed



Instructions:

- 1 The casting compound should first be mixed with water according to the mixing ratio indicated. Then divide the casting compound equally in the casting mould. However, it should not be filled to the brim to demould it easier later.
- 2 Once dry (the drying time depending on the casting material), you can demould your first gnome. If necessary, sand its rear side slightly. Leave your gnome to dry completely before designing it, preferably for several days.
- 3 Once completely dry, you can decorate the black gnome with the white acrylic paint.
- 4 To apply the mirror foil, first spread the foil glue on the gnome. Allow to dry. The foil glue become clear when dry, but remains sticky.
- 5 Place the mirror foil over the areas covered in glue, press it down firmly and remove it.
