Used items:

64 649 505	Wood pen blank + plank set, natural	1 pack
36 132 000	Silicone casting mould Illuminated house	1 piece
36 990 000	Casting powder "Raysin" 200, white	60 g
73 234 258	Paperado cardboard DIN A4, pinkish	1/20 sheet
73 234 288	Paperado cardboard DIN A4, brick-red	1/100 sheet
55 955 000	Tape display "Natural Life" (natural cord)	1 m
89 010 000	Frame hanger, 30 mm ø	1 piece

Additionally you need:

50 276 000	Clear Stamps "Welcome Home"
29 206 576	StazOn pigmented ink-pad, black
69 157 000	Motif puncher: Heart, 9 mm ø
33 487 000	Glue fix pen
89 324 000	Ticket punch, 3 mm ø

Scissors, mixing container for Raysin, scales

Instructions:

- 1 Cast the little house (about 1 cm thick) using the silicone casting mould Illuminated house. Once the house has dried, you can demould it.
- 2 Stamp the sentence "Zuhause ist es am" at the front side of the house.
- 3 The word "schönsten" has to be stamped on the pinkish paper. To do this, first cut a piece measuring 6.5 × 1.5 cm from the pinkish cardboard sheet and punch a hole in it by means of the ticket punch.
- 4 Glue the house onto the wood plank.
- 5 For the roof, glue the two wood pen blanks to the house.
- 6 Wind the jute cord twice around the house and attach the tag with the word "schönsten". Then simply tie a knot.
- 7 Use the motif puncher to make a heart out of the brick-red cardboard and glue it to the gable end of the roof.



- 8 The final step is to attach the suspension hook to the back of the wood plank.
