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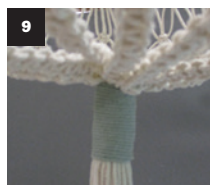
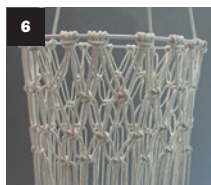
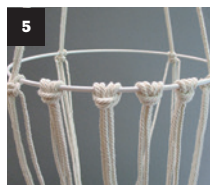
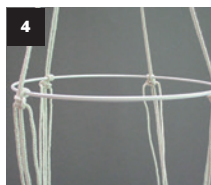
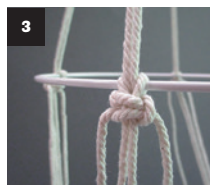


## Used items:

<b>44 000 502</b>	Macramé yarn set, 2,2mm ø, eucalyptus	2 sets
<b>25 052 00</b>	Metal rings, ø 20 cm, white	2 pieces
<b>25 208 00</b>	Metal rings to open, ø 38 mm	1 piece

## Additionally you need:

Scissors



## Instructions:

Yarn cuttings to be prepared:

### White yarn

4 × 4 m

36 × 3 m

### Eucalyptus-coloured yarn

4 × 20 cm for short windings

1 × 50 cm

1 × 2 m for winding the bottom part

- 1 Pass the 4 white yarns (4 m) through the small ring.
- 2 Tie these yarns together with the 50 cm long eucalyptus-coloured thread, making a wrap knot below the ring.
- 3 Attach a large metal ring to the long strands, taking 2 strands together each time, measuring 35 cm from the top winding up to the ring, then fix the ring in place with a lark's head knot.
- 4 Tie underneath a square knot with one of the white strands (3 m). Do the same with the rest of the strands.
- 5 Tie also the remaining 32 white yarns (3 m) to the ring by attaching 2 yarns to the ring again with the lark's head knot.
- 6 Now you need to weave a net by connecting 4 strings (each made up of 2 adjacent strands), with a 3 cm gap between them towards the top, using a full square knot. Repeat this step until 3 rows are formed.
- 7 After the last row, insert the second large metal ring into each strand using a full square knot.
- 8 Now, tie 9 square knots on each strand.
- 9 To make the bottom, bring all the knotted strands together towards the middle and tie them together with the 2 m long eucalyptus-coloured using a wrap knot.
- 10 Use each of the 4 short (20 cm) eucalyptus-coloured yarns to wrap each suspension strand using a wrap knot.



## Used items:

**44 000 502** Macramé yarn set, ø 2,2 mm, eucalyptus 1 set

## Additionally you need:

Scissors, planter

## Instructions:

Yarn cuttings to be prepared:

### White yarn

8 × 2,9 m

1 × 25 cm as suspension

### Eucalyptus-coloured yarn

1 × 1,5 m for the long winding of the bottom part

22 × 50 cm for the small windings (11 × wound)

1 × 70 cm for the winding of the upper part

- 1 Take the 8 cut white yarns (2.9 m) and put them together in half. For the suspension, place the short-cut white yarn (25 cm) between them and tie its two ends together. Wind a wrap knot around the upper part of each suspension cord using the eucalyptus-coloured yarn (70 cm).
- 2 Split each of the 4 yarns into 4 strands.
- 3 As for the part into which the planter will later be placed, wind each strand using a wrap knot. This will later be the top edge of the planter.
- 4 Now weave the container holder, always linking 4 cords (each made up of 2 adjacent strands) with a wrap knot. Repeat this step until you have reached the size of your container. Tie the wrap knots with the small eucalyptus-coloured yarns.
- 5 As for the bottom part, gather all the strands together and tie them with a wrap knot using the 1.5 m long eucalyptus-coloured yarn





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
