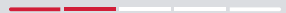




CRAFTING IDEA

GB

Create your own Christmassy dreams. Let yourself be seduced.



Used items:

- 46 582 102** Metal frame Macramé fir tree, white 1 piece
42 009 558 Braided Recycling yarn, braided, ø 2 mm, stone-grey 26 m

Additionally you need:

- 89 378 00** Craft scissors
33 406 00 Craft glue

Instructions:

Large one loosely wound

Insert the metal tree into the wooden base.

First cut 2 × 13 m pieces out of Braided Recycling yarn and wind each one in a clew.

Now knot firmly a piece of yarn at the top of the fir tree to the outer right metal rod and affix the knot with craft glue. Also knot the second yarn at the top of the fir tree to the outer left metal rod and affix the knot with craft glue too.

Then start with the right side. Wrap the yarn around the outer right metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the right outer metal rod to the back. Now put the yarn down.

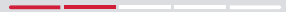
Now start with the left side. Wrap the yarn around the outer left metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the left outer metal rod to the back and then put the yarn down. Keep on holding tension on the yarn.

Then start again with the right side. Wrap again the yarn around the outer right metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the right outer metal rod to the back and then put the yarn down. Keep on holding tension on the yarn.

So continue working by alternating the right and the left sides.

Finally, knot each yarn and affix it with craft glue, then let it dry out and cut off all ends.





Used items:

46 581 102	Metal frame Macramé fir tree, white	1 piece
42 009 558	Braided Recycling yarn, braided, ø 2 mm, stone-grey	16 m

Additionally you need:

89 378 00	Craft scissors
33 406 00	Craft glue

Instructions:

Small one loosely wound

Insert the metal tree into the wooden base.

First cut 2 × 8 m pieces out of Braided Recycling yarn and wind each one in a clew.

Now knot firmly a piece of yarn at the top of the fir tree to the outer right metal rod and affix the knot with craft glue. Also knot the second yarn at the top of the fir tree to the outer left metal rod and affix the knot with craft glue too.

Then start with the right side. Wrap the yarn around the outer right metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the right outer metal rod to the back. Now put the yarn down.

Now start with the left side. Wrap the yarn around the outer left metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the left outer metal rod to the back and then put the yarn down. Keep on holding tension on the yarn.

Then start again with the right side. Wrap again the yarn around the outer right metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the right outer metal rod to the back and then put the yarn down. Keep on holding tension on the yarn.

So continue working by alternating the right and the left sides.

Finally, knot each yarn and affix it with craft glue, then let it dry out and cut off all ends.



Used items:

46 581 102 Metal frame Macramé fir tree, white 1 piece

42 009 558 Braided Recycling yarn, braided, ø 2 mm, stone-grey ca. 20 m

Additionally you need:

89 378 00 Craft scissors

33 406 00 Craft glue

Instructions:

Small one tightly wound

Insert the metal tree into the wooden base.

First cut 2 × 10 m pieces out of Braided Recycling yarn and wind each one in a clew.

Now knot firmly a piece of yarn at the top of the fir tree to the outer right metal rod and affix the knot with craft glue. Also knot the second yarn at the top of the fir tree to the outer left metal rod and affix the knot with craft glue too.

Then start with the right side. Wrap the yarn around the outer right metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the right outer metal rod to the back. Now put the yarn down.

Now start with the left side. Wrap the yarn around the outer left metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the left outer metal rod to the back and then put the yarn down. Keep on holding tension on the yarn.

Then start again with the right side. Wrap again the yarn around the outer right metal rod from the outside to the inside 4 times, then pass the yarn between the outer and the middle metal rod to the back and wrap it around the middle metal rod 2 times. Now pass the yarn between the middle and the right outer metal rod to the back and then put the yarn down. Keep on holding tension on the yarn.

So continue working by alternating the right and the left sides.

Finally, knot each yarn and affix it with craft glue, then let it dry out and cut off all ends.
