No more lost keys!
Macramé key ring.

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Used items:

44 000 502	Macramé yarn set, ø 2.2 mm, eucalyptus	1 set
22 247 21	Split ring, ø 9 mm	1 piece
22 761 21	Key ring, ø 25 mm, platinum	1 piece

Additionally you need:

Scissors, needle

Instructions:

Yarn cuttings to be prepared:

White yarn

3 × 2 m
1 × 80 cm

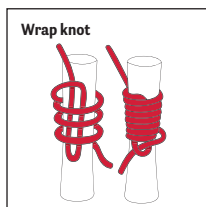
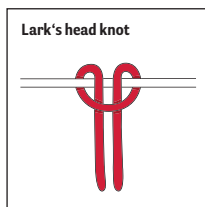
Eucalyptus-coloured yarn

3 × 12 cm
1 × 30 cm

- 1 Tie the three long pieces of white yarn (2 m) together on the key ring using a lark's head knot.
- 2 3.5 cm below the ring, tie a total of 20 square knots.
- 3 Now fold the strand in the middle so that the beginning and the end of the square knots are superimposed.
- 4 Cut off the rest of the yarn close to the ring. Now wind the white yarn (80 cm long) around the latter using a wrap knot.

Tassel

- 5 Pass the three eucalyptus-coloured yarns (12 cm long) through the split ring. Then wind the eucalyptus-coloured yarn (30 cm long) around the top of the tassel using a wrap knot.
- 6 As the final step, shorten the yarns to the desired length and split them with a needle.
