## Used items:

<b>46 837 505</b>	Veneer wood Rooster + chicken, natural	3 pieces
<b>46 757 000</b>	Glass vase, 15 cm ø	1 piece
<b>46 801 502</b>	Decorative metal tray, 20 + 25 cm ø, eucalyptus	1 piece
<b>46 729 000</b>	Deco quail eggs, blown-out	3 pieces
<b>55 965 616</b>	Ribbon + cord set, gold	approx. 55 cm
<b>39 339 102</b>	Sand, fine, white	approx. 350 ml
<b>54 080 102</b>	Paper anemone, 30 mm ø, white	1 piece
<b>85 004 11</b>	Icelandic moss, light green	1 piece
<b>85 143 02</b>	Decorative feather, white	4 pieces
<b>31 406 00</b>	Pillar candle	1 piece

## Additionally you need:

Scissors, hot-melt glue, dry twigs



## Instructions:

- 1 Wrap a golden ribbon around the glass vase. Glue a wooden veneer chicken onto the bottom of the glass vase using a hot-melt glue gun. Glue the remaining chickens onto the front.
- 2 Fill the vase with sand and put the candle on. Then put the vase in the middle of the tray.
- 3 Adorn the tray with moss, dry twigs and feathers.
- 4 Insert a paper anemone in the pierced hole of the quail egg and glue it onto the tray. Arrange the remaining quail eggs decoratively on the tray.
