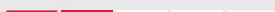

# Modelled Easter bowl

## Used items:

<b>34 105 00</b>	Air-drying modelling powder	¼ pack
<b>38 867 558</b>	DecoArt Chalky Finish, stone-grey	1/40 tin
<b>38 001 610</b>	DecoArt Metallic paint, brilliant silver	1/20 bottle
<b>38 001 620</b>	DecoArt Metallic paint, brilliant gold	1/20 bottle

## Additionally you need:

Balloon, tea light, decorative sand, brush



## Instructions:

- 1 For the preparation, you need a balloon inflated to the desired size and a support stand (e.g. flower pot) for the balloon.
- 2 Mix the modelling powder according to the package leaflet and apply the compound flatly with a wooden spatula onto the balloon until the desired height of the bowl is reached. Wrinkles or unevenness can be smoothly modelled with your fingers and a little water.
- 3 Let it dry out for about 1 day (the drying time is dependent upon the weather conditions).
- 4 Then, take carefully the balloon out or release the air with a little prick and remove it. For a special effect, you can pull the edges of the created bowl up or tear small pieces out.
- 5 After one more day of drying process, the bowl can be painted and decorated as desired.
