Natural soap with tree of life



Used items:

34 228 000	Creative-soap, opaque	about 120 g
34 266 000	Labels G: Lebensbaum, "voll dufte"	1 piece
34 232 000	Soap casting mould: square	1 piece
34 246 532	Soap colour, nougat	2-3 drops
34 250 000	Soap fragrance oil, vanilla	1 drop

Additionally you need:

Stove, pot, melting pot, scale, small plastic container, stirrers or teaspoon, tablespoon



Instructions:

1 Melt the creative-soap in a water-bath on the stove (max. 60° - do not boil).

2 After a complete melting, stir in the plastic container into the liquid soap two/three drops of the nougat soap colour and 1 drop of the fragrance oil vanilla.

3 Therefore, use a craft stick or a teaspoon.

4 For the soaps with motif or logo, place upwards the label with the stamping. To avoid blistering or slipping of the label, use at best a tablespoon with which you fill the casting mould with the liquid soap.

5 Let the soap dry well out (at least 2-3 hours, ideally one day). Demould the soap by a slight pressure.

6 Remove the label at best with a pointed object e.g. a needle.

Tip Let the finished soap dry at best for 2-3 weeks; the longer it ripens, the firmer becomes.

7 Depending on the temperature and airiness, the soap can perspire. We therefore recommend to wrap the soap after its demoulding in a transparent foil for flowers (cellophane).

8 Clean the soap casting mould and the pots with hot water.
