Dip-Dye Easter candles.

Used items:

31 641 102	Taper candle, ø 2.1 cm, white	3 pieces
31 042 02	Wax pellets	approx.250 g/hue
31 640 990	Colour pigments for wax, rainbow	1 piece/hue
31 640 999	Colour pigments for wax, colourful	2 pieces/2 hues
31 661 000	Transfer foil "Frohe Ostern"	1 piece
55 965 412	Ribbon + cord set, pea-green	approx.60 cm
46 778 999	Wooden shapes "Birdy", colourful	1 piece

Additionally you need:

Dipping vessel, pot, stovetop, knife, scissors, wooden stick

Instructions:

- 1 Fill a narrow, tall vessel to about $\frac{3}{4}$ with wax pellets for each colour pigment. Then, heat each one in a bain-marie until all the wax pellets have melted. However, make sure the water doesn't boil. Crush the colour pigment with a knife and mix it evenly by stirring with a wooden stick. The more colour pigments are added, the more intense the colour shade.
- 2 Now take the taper candle, dip it into the dyed, liquid wax and let it dry. By dipping it several times and allowing to dry, the colour shade becomes more intense.
- 3 As soon as each dipped layer has dried, decorate the candle with one of the motifs from the transfer foil "Frohe Ostern".
- 4 Cut a piece of ribbon or cord about 60 cm long and wind it around the candles. The final stage is to attach the small wooden flower to the ribbon or cord.
