33 242 00	Styrofoam-frog, 13 cm	1 piece
39 313 01	Round spangles, convex, 6 mm ø, black	1 box
39 313 02	Round spangles, convex, 6 mm ø, white	1 box
39 313 12	Round spangles, convex, 6 mm ø, blue-green	2 boxes
39 313 14	Round spangles, convex, 6 mm ø, olive green	1 box
39 313 58	Round spangles, convex, 6 mm ø, yellow gold	1 box
21 485 00	Pins	2 boxes

Additionally you need:

Tweezers, mini-picker

Instructions:

- 1 Hold the spangles by means of tweezers, lay them onto styrofoam and fix them firmly with pins. Alternatively you can work with the mini-picker. Tack all convex spangles firmly downwards towards the styrofoam.
- 2 Firstly, work on frog's eyes (the white areas); then for the pupils, place 3 black spangles over. Put black spangles onto both leg cavities (front & rear side), the mouth and cheeks to achieve 3D-effect.
- 3 As a next step, insert the yellow details of the feet, then continue with the light green areas of the feet that go up to the frog's leg. Thereby, use different shades of green. Always incorporate the dark spangles. For effects on larger surfaces, use a light or dark spangle.
- 4 Apply light green tones on the face of the frog; for the belly, the back, the back of the head and the eyelid of the frog use the dark green spangles.
