## Used items:

<b>67 270 102</b>	Tissue paper, white	1/3 sheet
<b>67 270 258</b>	Tissue paper, pinkish	1/3 sheet
<b>67 270 210</b>	Tissue paper, orange	1/3 sheet
<b>67 270 360</b>	Tissue paper, sky blue	1/3 sheet
<b>67 270 312</b>	Tissue paper, lavender	1/3 sheet
<b>24 056 00</b>	Florist's wire	2 m
<b>51 051 14</b>	Crepe ribbon, olive	1.5 m

## Additionally you need:

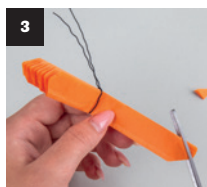
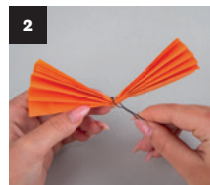
Scissors



## Instructions:

You will need, for each flower, 4 layers of tissue paper per colour, each measuring 15 × 15 cm.

- 1 Lay the tissue paper sheets one on top of the other and start folding them from side to side to get a fan shape (one fold – 1.5 cm).
- 2 Bind the folded paper strips in the middle with the florist's wire and then fold them down.
- 3 The outer edges need to be trimmed using scissors, rounding them off or making them sharp.
- 4 Carefully split up each fold of the fan by giving it the shape of a petal.
- 5 And finally, roll up the crepe paper all along the flower stem.
