## Additionally you need:

$\mathbf{8 9} 288000$ Aluminium ruler
Pencil

## Instructions:

1 Copy out the template to the rear side of the desired scrapbooking paper via distinctive dots by using a pencil and a ruler.

2 Cut out the copied box along the solid line by means of the precision craft cutter or scissors.

3 Connect the distinctive dots with the ruler without marking them and trace them with the bone folder. Now you can fold the paper box.

4 Stick the box together at the flaps with the extra strong double-sided adhesive tape.

TIP: You will find attached hereto indicated paper box height of 10 cm . But you can also use various heights ( 10,12 and 14 cm ) to make a whole bunch of paper boxes.
