



CRAFTING IDEA



Paper star with fairy lights



Used items:

67 246 102	Paper folding bag, white	9 pieces
69 137 000	Micro LED-fairy lights with wire	1 piece
33 406 000	Craft glue	1/5 bottle
39 420 620	Sequins, ultra-fine, PET, brill, gold	1/15 bottle
38 952 000	Small paint pad, 50 x 20 x 20 mm	1 piece
28 395 620	Stamp pad "Versacolor", brill, gold	1 piece
30 068 000	Special double-sided adh. tape	1.5 m
89 568 000	Magnet, 6 mm ø	2 pieces
69 001 000	Punch pliers, motif Star, 6 mm ø	1 piece
89 012 000	Motif-puncher: Fir tree, 2.54 cm ø	1 piece
89 792 000	Motif-puncher: Star, 1.6 cm ø	1 piece

Additionally you need:

67 254 000	Set: Magic stars: Stencil No. 1
89 379 000	Pointed/sharp paper scissors 11 cm
	Pencil
Batteries:	2 × lithium-button cells 3V



Instructions:

- Copy the stencil from the cutting-pattern onto a sturdy cardboard and cut it out according to the template.
- Lay the stencil onto the paper bag (flap facing up) and fix the stencil at the lower rim of the paper bag by means of a brass money clip.
- Trace the stencil by a pencil. Mark the spots of the star and the fir tree. Remove the stencil.
- Now cut along the accurately defined markings.
- Punch the star and the tree with the respective motif-punchers out. Repeat it until the specified quantity of bags is reached. You need 9 paper folding bags for the star.
- Trace the outer edges of all bags with the golden stamp pad.
- Affix along bag's midst and lower rim of the bags (see illustration) a strip of a double-sided adhesive tape. Leave the last bag out.
- Stick the bags together evenly one above the other, so that a stack is formed.
- Affix the magnets with a white sticker (see markings) at the inner side of the first & last bag.
- Now, spread the craft glue with sponge on the folded star at its long and short side, and scatter the golden sequins over the still wet glue.
- Finally, unfold the star straightaway (so it does not stick together) and let it dry.
- To suspend the star, pierce a small hole through a star-tip by means of a needle and thread for e.g. a nylon thread or a thin strip/cord through it.
