

**CRAFTING IDEA** 

Paper star with fairy lights

Paper folding bag, white	9 pieces
Micro LED-fairy lights with wire	1 piece
Craft glue	1/5 bottle
Sequins, ultra-fine, PET, brill.gold	1/15 bottle
Small paint pad, 50 x 20 x 20 mm	1 piece
Stamp pad "Versacolor", brill.gold	1 piece
Special double-sided adh.tape	1.5 m
Magnet, 6 mm ø	2 pieces
Punch pliers, motif Star, 6 mm ø	1 piece
Motif-puncher: Fir tree, 2.54 cm ø	1 piece
Motif-puncher: Star, 1.6 cm ø	1 piece
	Micro LED-Tairy lights with wire Craft glue Sequins, ultra-fine, PET, brill, gold Small paint pad, 50 x 20 x 20 mm Stamp pad "Versacolor", brill, gold Special double-sided adh.tape Magnet, 6 mm ø Punch pliers, motif Star, 6 mm ø Motif-puncher: Fir tree, 2.54 cm ø

## Additionally you need:

Pencil

Batteries: 2 × lithium-button cells 3V



## Instructions:

- 1 Copy the stencil from the cutting-pattern onto a sturdy cardboard and cut it out according to the template.
- 2 Lay the stencil onto the paper bag (flap facing up) and fix the stencil at the lower rim of the paper bag by means of a brass money clip.
- 3 Trace the stencil by a pencil. Mark the spots of the star and the fir tree. Remove the stencil.
- 4 Now cut along the accurately defined markings.
- 5 Punch the star and the tree with the respective motif-punchers out. Repeat it until the specified quantity of bags is reached. You need 9 paper folding bags for the star.
- 6 Trace the outer edges of all bags with the golden stamp pad.

- 7 Affix along bag's midst and lower rim of the bags (see illustration) a strip of a double-sided adhesive tape. Leave the last bag out.
- 8 Stick the bags together evenly one above the other, so that a stack is formed
- 9 Affix the magnets with a white sticker (see markings) at the inner side of the first & last bag.
- 10 Now, spread the craft glue with sponge on the folded star at its long and short side, and scatter the golden sequins over the still wet glue.
- 11 Finally, unfold the star straightaway (so it does not stick together) and let it dry.
- 12 To suspend the star, pierce a small hole through a star-tip by means of a needle and thread for e.g. a nylon thread or a thin strip/cord through it.
