# Pomponella Bridegroom



## Used items:

<b>76 013 376</b>	Soft tulle pompoms, assorted, blue-gray shades	1 piece
<b>62 508 00</b>	Raw-wood balls, drilled-through, 23 mm ø	1 piece
<b>12 517 00</b>	Wooden bead mix FSC 100%, 8 mm ø, black&white	3 pieces
<b>89 473 01</b>	Decorative cord, black	45 cm
<b>22 195 06</b>	Lobster clasp, gold	1 piece
<b>39 150 01</b>	Velour top hat, 3 cm ø, black	1 piece
<b>38 000 512</b>	All Purpose paint, nude	1/100 bottle
<b>38 000 100</b>	All Purpose paint, snow-white	1/120 bottle
<b>38 000 576</b>	All Purpose paint, black	1/100 bottle
<b>38 000 284</b>	All Purpose paint, vivid red	1/200 bottle
<b>55 214 19</b>	Satin ribbon, ruby-coloured	5 cm

## Additionally you need:

- 37 052 000** Paintbrush set Hobby Kreativ, FSC 100 %
  - 89 378 00** Craft scissors
  - 89 543 00** Side cutter for jewellery
- Needle & sewing thread, possibly toothpick



## Instructions:

- 1** Insert the raw-wood ball onto a paintbrush tip or a suitable wooden stick.
- 2** Paint the raw-wood ball, to serve as a head, by means of the paintbrush from the set. You can sketch out the face as an aid with a pencil (example template enclosed). For the face, start with the All Purpose paint, colour nude, which you lighten a bit with the All Purpose paint, colour snow-white. Paint the hair and the rest of the face afterwards. For the cheeks, mix a drop of the vivid red paint with the white paint. Allow to dry well out.
- 3** Drill a hole in the middle of the top hat with a needle or toothpick.
- 4** Thread 20 cm of the black jewellery cord through the eyelet of the lobster clasp. Lay both ends of the decorative cord on top of each other and thread both ends through the top hat and the small head. As a spacing element between the head (raw-wood ball) and the body (soft tulle pompon), thread through a white bead from the wooden bead mix.

**TIP:** A toothpick makes it easier to push the decorative cord through the raw-wood ball hole.

- 5** After that, tie a knot so that the lobster clasp gets more space to move. Tie a simple knot in the middle with the remaining decorative cord. Now, sew firmly the head and the legs separately to the inside of the pompon with a matching sewing thread. Always sew the ends of the thread.

- 6** Then, thread the black wooden beads from the mix as shoes and tie a knot at the desired leg length. Cut off the cord ends.

- 7** Finally, tie a satin ribbon bow and wrap it with the gold brass wire and place it between the neck and the head.

**TIP:** The Pomponellas can be worn on a necklace, used as a bag charm, for a baby mobile or on a gift wrapping.
