Flowers out of Raysin

36 090 000 36 990 00	Casting mould: flower, 17 cm ø	1 piece
	Casting powder "Raysin" 200 Chalky Finish, jade	800 g 1/20 bottle
38 867 264	Chalky Finish, pink	1/20 bottle
38 867 266	Chalky Finish, salmon pink	1/20 bottle
45 105 000	Stencil Wish A5	1 piece
38 001 620	Metallic paint, brill.gold	1/30 bottle
39 420 620	Sequin spangles, ultrafine PET	1/30 bottle



61 217 31 Craft sticks
89 530 00 Sandpaper
37 075 000 Plastic container
Kitchen roll
Scales



Instructions:

- 1 Fill the plastic container with about 230 g of water and then gradually & slowly add about 800 g of the Raysin. Stir the mixture with a craft stick until an uniform and castable compound is obtained. Pour the mixture into the mould and let it dry out best overnight.
- 2 The next day, you can remove the flower from the mould by turning the casting mould over and by pressing slightly several times with the palm of your hand against the casting mould until the flower becomes entirely detached from the mould.

Allow the demoulded flower to harden well. At best for 1-2 days.

Small burrs and irregularities can be sanded with some sandpaper.

3 For the designing, take the desired Chalky Finish colour and paint the entire edge of the flower with a brush. Let the colour application dry well out.

Then, place the stencil over the flower.

Press the stencil well on and stencil with the brush and the chosen Chalky Finish paint, and finally remove the stencil and let it dry out.
