Ready to welcome spring? Standing Raysin decoration.

Used items:

36 067 000	Casting mould: Egg	1 piece
36 990 00	Casting powder "Raysin" 200	800 g
46 729 000	Deco quail eggs	4 pieces
54 079 159	Small paper roses, ø 15 mm, light-yellow	3 pieces
46 738 505	Wooden shapes Blossoms, natural	11 pieces
35 077 100	Allround Paint acrylic, snow-white	approx.6 ml
35 077 160	Allround Paint acrylic, lemon	approx. 2 ml
35 077 208	Allround Paint acrylic, tangerine	approx. 2 ml
35 077 452	Allround Paint acrylic, avocado	approx. 2 ml
35 077 506	Allround Paint acrylic, sandalwood	approx. 2 ml

Additionally you need:

33 487 000 Glue fix pen

Mixing vessel, poss. sandpaper, paintbrush, adhesive tape

Instructions:

- 1 Mix the white Raysin casting powder with water according to the instructions given, then fill the casting mould with the resulting casting compound. Place four quail eggs in the still soft casting compound (about 1 cm from the bottom edge) and secure them carefully in place using the adhesive tape. After 240 minutes drying time, carefully demould the egg and let it dry for a while.
- 2 Paint the wooden flowers with Allround Paint and allow them to dry thoroughly.
- 3 Glue the painted wooden flowers in the shape of a wreath onto the Raysin egg using the glue fix pen.
- Insert two small yellow paper roses in the tiny hole of one of the 4 quail eggs.
