# Butterfly out of Raysin



## Used items:

<b>36 091 000</b>	Casting mould: butterfly	1 piece
<b>36 990 00</b>	Casting powder „Raysin“ 200	500 g
<b>38 000 564</b>	All Purpose paint, mouse-grey	1/30 bottle
<b>45 097 000</b>	Stencil Smile A4	1 piece

## Additionally you need:

<b>61 217 31</b>	Craft sticks
<b>89 530 00</b>	Sandpaper
<b>37 075 000</b>	Set of brushes
	Plastic container
	Kitchen roll
	Scales



## Instructions:

**1** Fill the plastic container with about 143 g of water and then gradually & slowly add about 500 g of the Raysin. Stir the mixture with a craft stick until a uniform and castable compound is obtained. Pour the mixture into the mould and let it dry out best overnight.

**2** The next day, you can remove the butterfly from the mould by turning the casting mould over and by pressing slightly several times with the palm of your hand against the casting mould until the butterfly becomes entirely detached from the mould. Allow the demoulded butterfly to harden well. At best for 1-2 days. Small burrs and irregularities can be sanded with some sandpaper.

**3** For the designing, take some All Purpose paint (mouse-grey) and paint the entire edge of the butterfly with a brush. Let the colour application dry well out. Then, place the stencil with the desired text over the butterfly. Press the stencil well on and stencil the text with the brush and the mouse-grey All Purpose paint, then remove the stencil and let it dry out.
