#### **Used items:**

36 150 000	Casting mould U-shaped vase, ridged	1 piece
Vase 1 (white below, black above)		
36 990 00	Casting powder Raysin 200	150 g
34 479 576	Casting powder Raysin 250, black	100 g
Vase 2 (blac	k below, white above)	
36 990 00	Casting powder Raysin 200	100 σ

## Additionally you need:

34 479 576 Casting powder Raysin 250, black

Water, mixing vessel, funnel Sandpaper if necessary



# Instructions:

#### Vase 1 (white below, black above)

- 1 In the first place, mix the black casting powder Raysin with water as per instructions.
- 2 Pour half of the mixture into one side of the U-shape using a funnel. Take care that the hole-inlay remains straight. Pour likewise the other half into the other side of the U-shape.
- 3 After drying of about 60 minutes, stir the white casting powder Raysin. Fill the mould with the resulting white Raysin mixture.
- 4 After another 60 minutes drying time, your artwork can be demoulded.
- 5 Allow the vase to cure thoroughly, at best overnight.

### Vase 2 (black below, white above)

To make the upper part of the vase white and the lower part of the vase black, start by mixing the white Raysin. Pour in equal proportions using the funnel, let it dry and fill up with the black Raysin. Let it dry, demould and cure again.
