Self-made, quite naturally.
Test tubes as a well-being decor.



Used items:

65 397 505	Viennese wickerwork, natural	12.5 × 10 cm
65 398 505	Rattan wickerwork, natural	12.5 × 10 cm
88 013 00	Test tube, ø 30 mm	2 pieces
65 029 00	Rattan strip, 4 mm	approx. 1 m
35 047 102	Chalky, white	some
85 493 000	Eucalyptus bunch with paper sleeve	2 twigs

Additionally you need:

Hot-melt glue, scissors, paintbrush, pencil, ruler
Nylon thread for hanging if required



Instructions:

1 Using a ruler, draw a rectangle with a pencil on the Viennese wicker and a rectangle on the rattan wicker, each measuring 12.5 × 10 cm, then cut out both of them by means of scissors. Use, however, the lower fringe-trimmed part of both wickerworks.

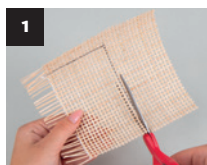
2 Join the two sides/edges of each rectangle to form a roll and fix them in place by means of the hot-melt glue.

3 Paint 25 cm of the rattan strip in white with the Chalky paint and let it dry thoroughly.

4 Cut the unpainted part of the rattan strip to the desired length to get two strips, then glue the ends of each to the two rolls respectively so that they act as suspension.

5 Glue now as decorative borders the two white-painted rattan strips (12.5 cm each) to the top edge of each roll by means of the hot-melt glue.

Finally, put the eucalyptus twigs in each test tube.
