„Dinner's served!“
All-natural napkin ring.



Used items:

|-------------------|--|---------|
| 62 500 00 | Raw wood ring, 5.5 cm ø | 1 piece |
| 24 116 505 | Paper covered wire, 0.55 mm ø, natural | 50 cm |
| 42 000 504 | Jute cord on wooden card, 1.5 mm ø, sand | 250 cm |

Additionally you need:

- 33 487 000** Glue fix pen
Scissors, wire stripper

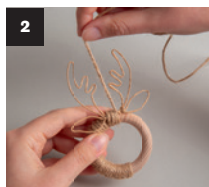
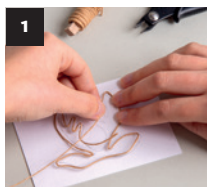
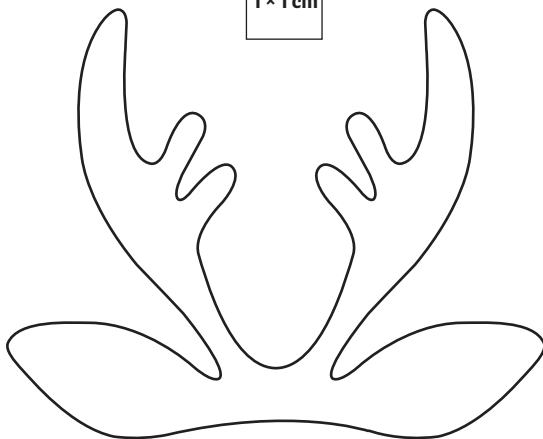
Instructions:

- 1 Cut a 50 cm long piece of paper-covered wire. Then shape the wire into the shape of a deer antler using the template.
- 2 Cut a 250 cm piece of string from the jute cord and wrap it around the raw wood ring. Attach the antler to the middle of the ring.
- 3 Secure the two ends of the jute cord in place using the glue fix pen.
- 4 Slide your napkin into the ring.
