Additionally you need:

30 071 000 Double-sided adhesive tape extra strong Utility knife, scissors, tweezers, paintbrush

Instructions:

Rub On transfer foils can be applied on Raysin, wood, papier-mâché and standard paper. They are applied to all these surfaces in the same way. The surface can be designed as desired.

- 1 Cut out the motifs from the transfer foil "Rub on" X-Mas using scissors.
- **2** Then transfer these very same motifs to the dry surfaces by removing the carrier paper first. Place the motif in its intended place.
- 3 Rub it with a blunt object, such as the handle of a pair of tweezers.
- 4 Finally, remove the protective foil.
