Round wooden tray  
with mini-garden

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## Used items:

<b>62 731 000</b>	Wooden tray, FSC Mix Credit, 30 cm ø	1 piece
<b>39 342 508</b>	Granulate, beige	1 pack
<b>85 288 000</b>	Round pine-slices	3/4 package
<b>85 004 31</b>	Natural iceland moss	1/4 package
<b>55 734 000</b>	Vanilla Grass to insert	1 bag
<b>55 735 000</b>	Mini box tree branch	1 1/2 bag
<b>46 066 102</b>	Garden sitting set 3-part, white	1 bag
<b>46 055 102</b>	Iron fence white	1 bag
<b>88 268 00</b>	Metallic watering can + bucket 2 types	3 pieces
<b>33 408 00</b>	Craft glue	300 g
<b>65 068 000</b>	Clematis-wreath, natural, 15 cm ø	some
<b>33 364 00</b>	Hot glue gun	1 piece
<b>37 104 00</b>	Flat brush	



## Instructions:

- 1 Place the pine-slices centrally on the tray and affix them with the hot glue.
- 2 The remaining inner side of the tray has to be coated with the hot glue by means of the flat brush, then scatter the granulate across the tray.
- 3 Now leave the tray to dry out and repeat this procedure until the granulate has reached the height of the pine-slices.
- 4 Sink the iron fence semicircularly into the granulate until it still "soft" is. Then let it dry.
- 5 Affix the decorative plants (vanilla grass, mini box tree branch and natural iceland moss) at the border of the tray with the hot glue.
- 6 Now decorate the tray with the garden sitting set, watering can, bucket and flower pot, and secure all with the hot glue.
