Used items:

Key ring, jade

62 491 00	Raw wood balls FSC 100%, 25 mm ø	1 piece
62 489 00	Raw wood balls FSC 100%, 20 mm ø	3 pieces
22 287 00	Key ring with carabiner, 25 mm ø	1 piece
35 017 102	Chalky Finish marker, white	1 piece
35 017 432	Chalky Finish Marker, jade	1 piece
35 014 616	Extreme Sheen, gold	5 ml
38 874 000	Clear varnish, satin matt	20 ml
83 018 02	Round lace of goatskin, 1,5 mm ø	30 cm

Key ring, pinkish

62 491 00	Raw wood balls FSC 100%, 25 mm ø	1 piece
62 489 00	Raw wood balls FSC 100%, 20 mm ø	3 piece
22 287 00	Key ring with carabiner, 25 mm ø	1 piece
35 017 258	Chalky Finish marker, pinkish	1 piece
35 017 102	Chalky Finish marker, white	1 piece
35 014 616	Extreme Sheen, gold	5 ml
38 874 000	Clear varnish, satin matt	20 ml
83 018 02	Round lace of goatskin, 1,5 mm ø	30 cm

Additionally you need:

37 051 000	Set of brushes Hobby Kreativ, FSC 100%
89 377 00	Craft scissors, 20.5cm



Instruction:

- 1 Paint the whole surface of the raw wood ball (25 mm ø) with the jade Chalky Finish marker. Allow the paint to dry well out and then paint it 2 more times.
- 2 Then paint the whole surface of the raw wood ball (20 mm ø) with the gold Extreme Sheen paint, let it dry well out and paint it again.
- 3 Thereafter, paint two raw wood balls (20 mm ø) with the jade & white Chalky Finish marker (according to the illustration), let them dry well out and paint them again in order to achieve a nice opaque paint application.
- 4 Once you have painted all raw wood balls, the next step is to apply a layer of satin matt clear varnish by means of the brush # 12.

- 5 Thread the round lace of goatskin through the key ring, place it in the middle and thread the raw wood balls (according to the illustration) and fix the wooden balls with an overhand knot *.

- 6 Cut off the round lace leaving a length of about 2 cm.

Accordingly, the key ring can be designed in a pink/white/gold colour scheme.
