## **Used items:**

55 517 287	Yarn, ø 1 mm, classic red	2.20 m
67 302 999	Metallic crush paper mix, A4, colourful	1 sheet
12 504 18	Wooden beads FSC 100%, polished, ø 12 mm, red	4 pieces
46 093 000	Snowballs with glitter, ø 2.5 cm	7 pieces
67 375 576	Tinted cardboard, DIN A4, black	1 sheet
67 374 100	Tinted cardboard, FSC Mix Credit, snow-white	2 sheets
67 376 999	Craft paper, colour-assorted, DIN A4, colourful	

## **Additionally you need:**

**33 396 00** Paper glue sewing needle

## Instruction:

- 1 Cut out the required pattern pieces from the craft paper using the cutting template.
- 2 Glue the individual pattern pieces together.
- 3 Using e.g. a sewing needle, poke a hole at the tip of each star. Thread the red and the white yarn through the hole and thread on an additional wooden bead.
- 4 Now you can string the garland to your liking. It's best to use a sewing needle when stringing, this way you can pierce the snowballs more easily.



TIP: If you glue a small crosspiece made from a strip of paper to the back of the snowman's hat and at the top of the tree, the snowman and the tree will hang more nicely on the garland.
